### A WORD ABOUT THE LESSONS

The Preaching of the Word of Christ Bears the Good Fruits of Faith and Love - As "the rain and the snow come down from heaven" and "water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout" (Is. 55:10), so the Word of God accomplishes the purpose for which He speaks it, granting joy and peace through the forgiveness of sins and producing the fruits of faith and love in those who are called by His name.
