**P** Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, with gratitude and joy we give thanks this day for Pastor Louis Nuechterlein, who 60 years ago was installed in the Office of the Holy Ministry in the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church here at Cheshire Lutheran. We thank God that He established this office in His Church through which “are imparted not bodily, but eternal things and gifts, namely, eternal righteousness, the Holy Spirit, and eternal life.” We praise the Lord that He has permitted His servant to serve His Church in this community these 60 years and that He has sustained and supported him and blessed his ministry among us.

We also give thanks this day for this building that is the home of Cheshire Lutheran Church, as ground was broken here 60 years ago. We thank God that He established this house of prayer where His Word is preached and His Sacraments are administered. We praise the Lord that He has permitted this congregation to proclaim His name in this place these 60 years and that He has blessed the ministry here.

**P** Hear the Word of the Lord:

**P** <sup>47</sup>Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like: <sup>48</sup>he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. <sup>49</sup>But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great.”

**P** <sup>3</sup>I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, <sup>4</sup>always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, <sup>5</sup>because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. <sup>6</sup>And I am sure of this, that he who began a good

work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. <sup>7</sup>It is right for me to feel this way about you all, because I hold you in my heart, for you are all partakers with me of grace, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. <sup>8</sup>For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus.

**P** <sup>58</sup>Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

**P** This is the Word of the Lord.

**C** **Thanks be to God.**

We give thanks that through Your Word You also called Louis as Your servant and entrusted him with the Office of the Holy Ministry. We praise Your mercy and faithfulness and ask that You continue to keep him in good health and firm faith. Grant that he may continue to be a blessing to Your people and that they may be a blessing to him. Open everywhere the hearts of the faithful that Your Word may be received and that laborers in Your harvest may not be lacking. Cause Your Church to grow up into Him who is the head, even Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
