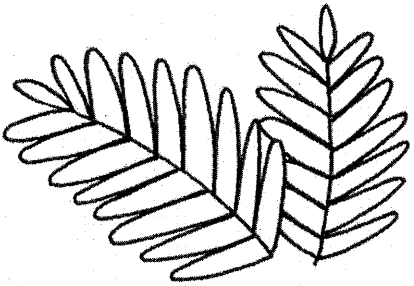


SOMETHING to DRAW

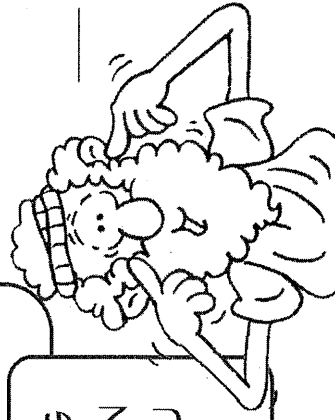
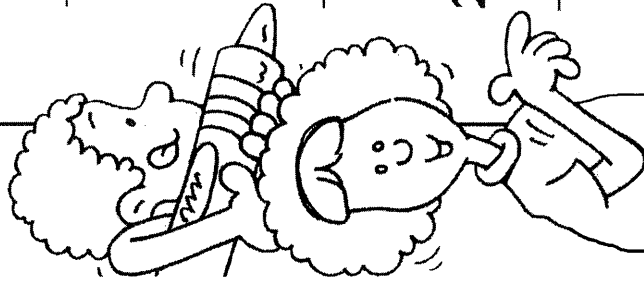
