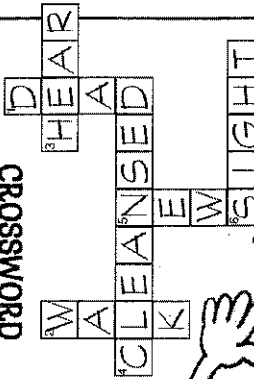

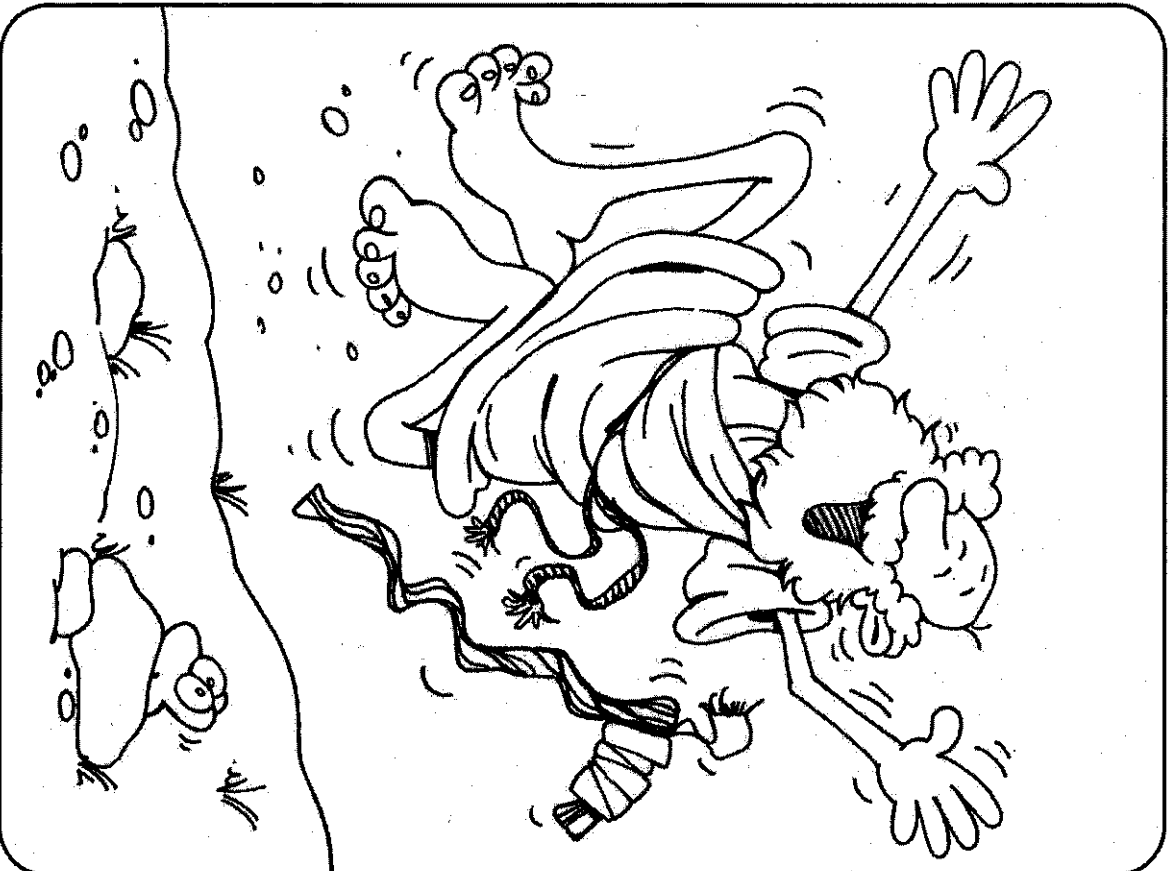

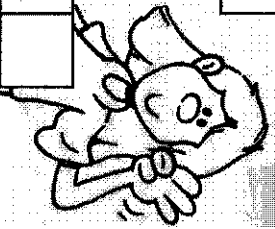
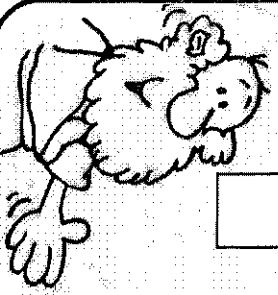
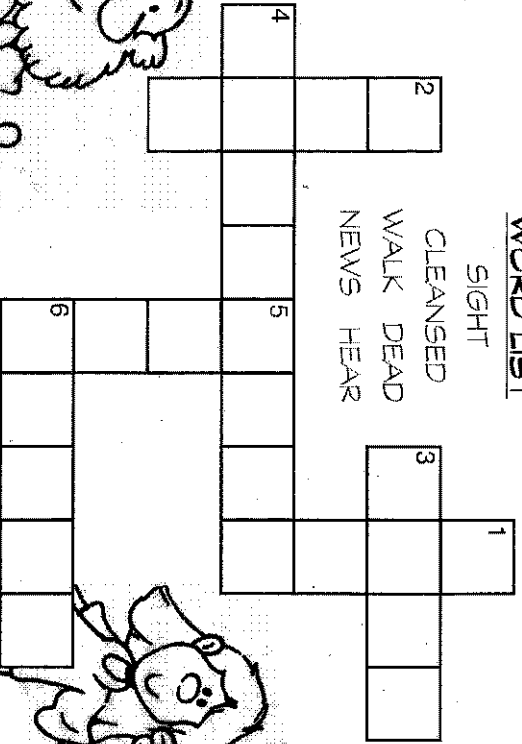
CROSSWORD PUZZLE
