**CONFESSION and FORGIVENESS**  
*all standing*

In the name of the Father, and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

Rejoicing in the resurrection, let us seek God's forgiveness, that dying to sin, we may walk in newness of life.

*(all kneel)*  
*(silence for reflection and self-examination)*

Faithful God, **we confess that we have tried to live by our own strength, shunning the power of the resurrection. We have doubted our promises. We have sinned against our neighbor and against you by the things we have done and left undone. Have mercy on us, loving Father; forgive us our sin, and restore to us the joy of your salvation, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

Christ died to sin once for all, and now, victorious, lives to God and for his sake God grants you pardon and peace. As his called and ordained servant, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son + and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**
