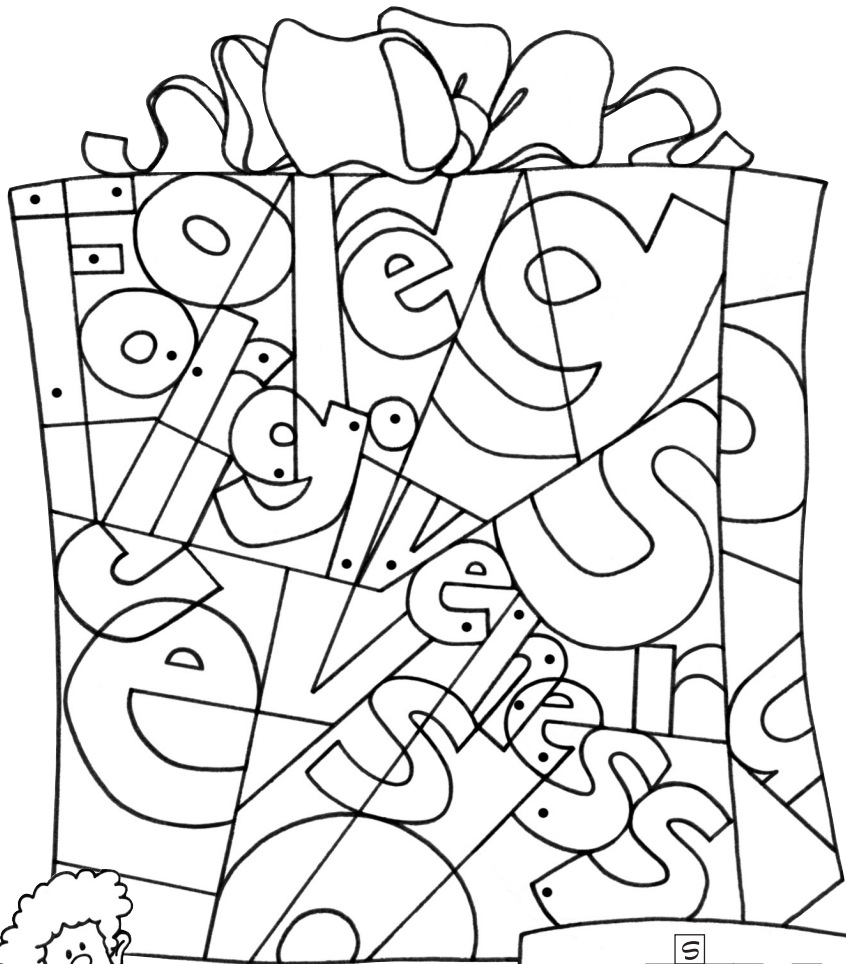


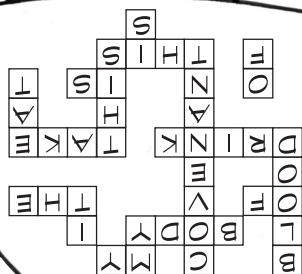
HIDDEN PICTURE

The Gospel tells of a special gift Jesus gives through His body and blood. Color the spaces with the dots to find out what that special gift is.



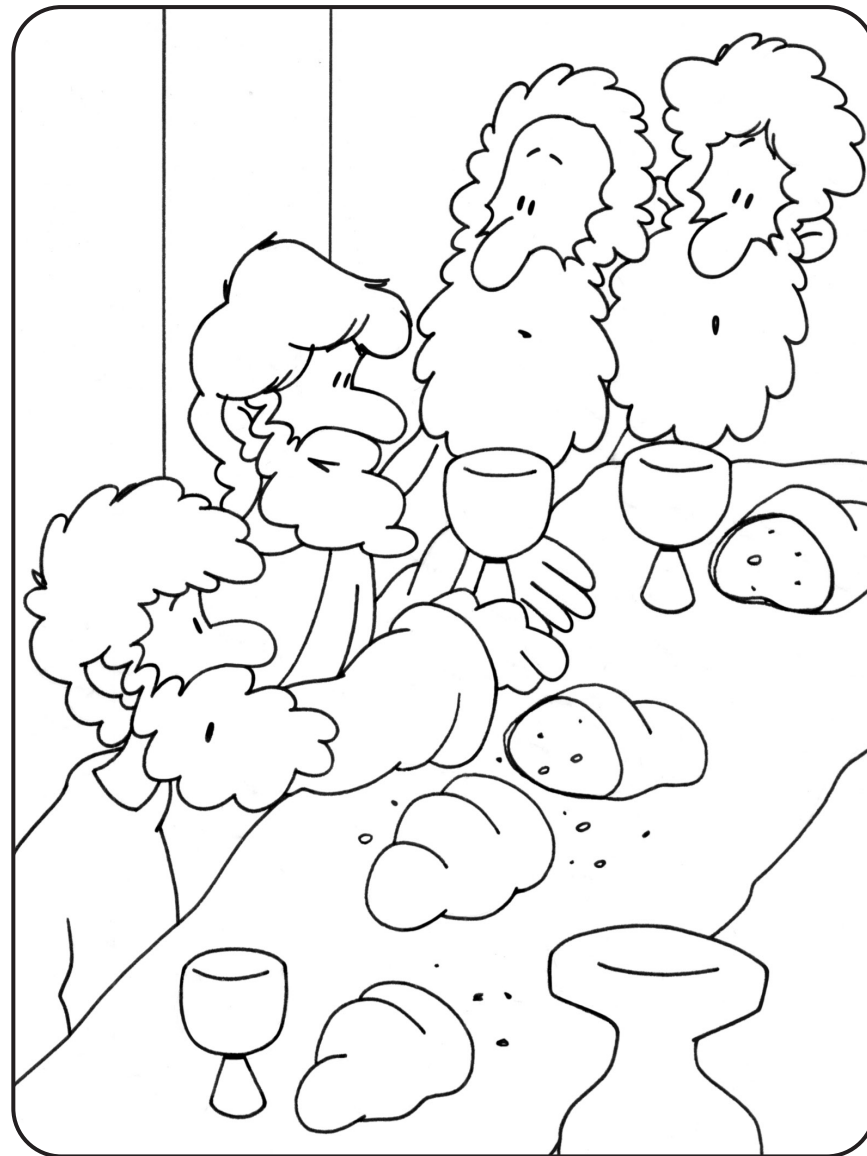

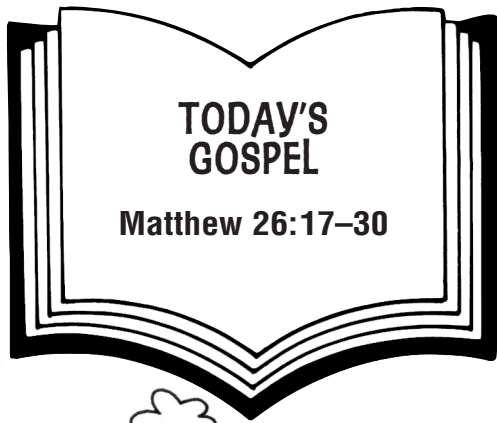
Holy (Maundy) Thursday

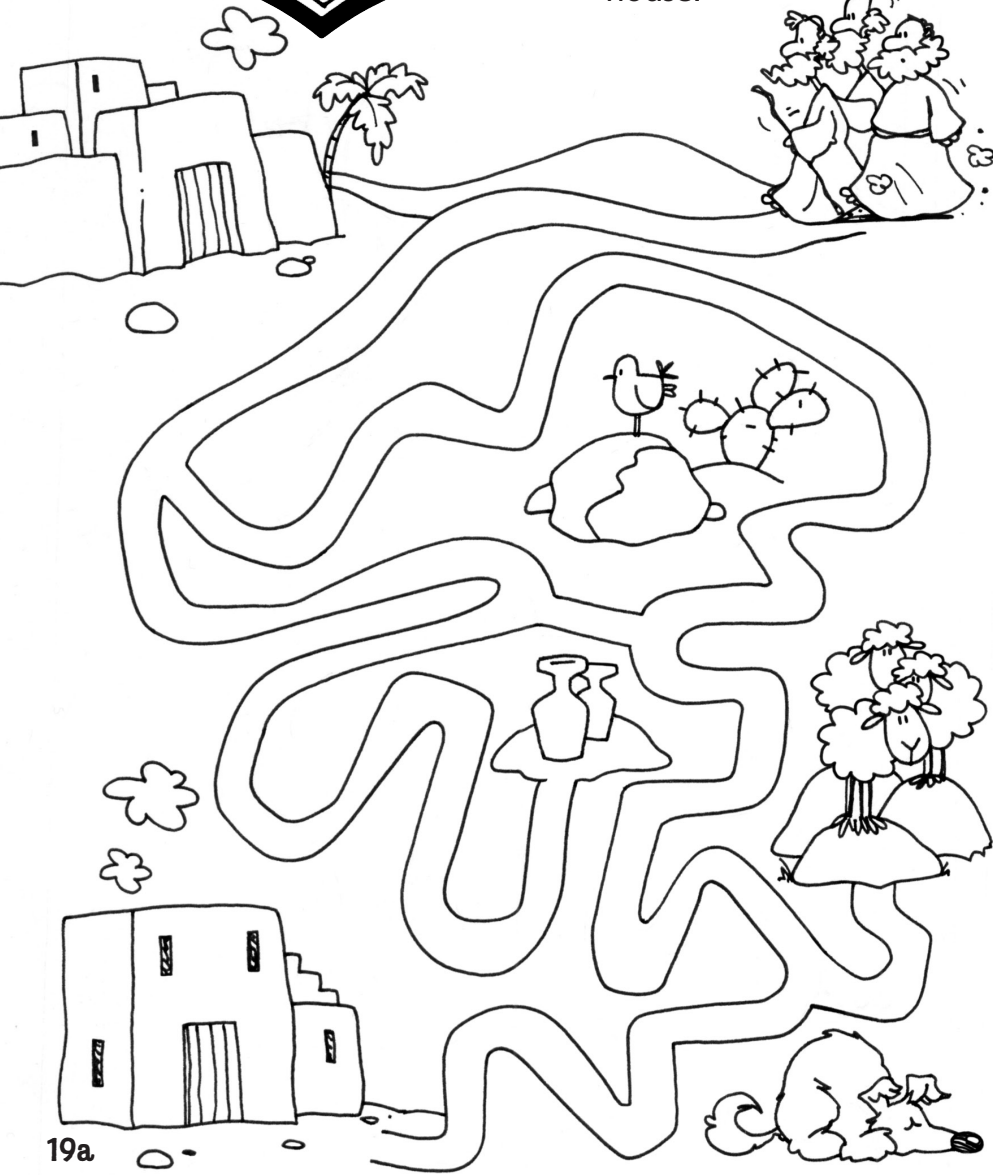

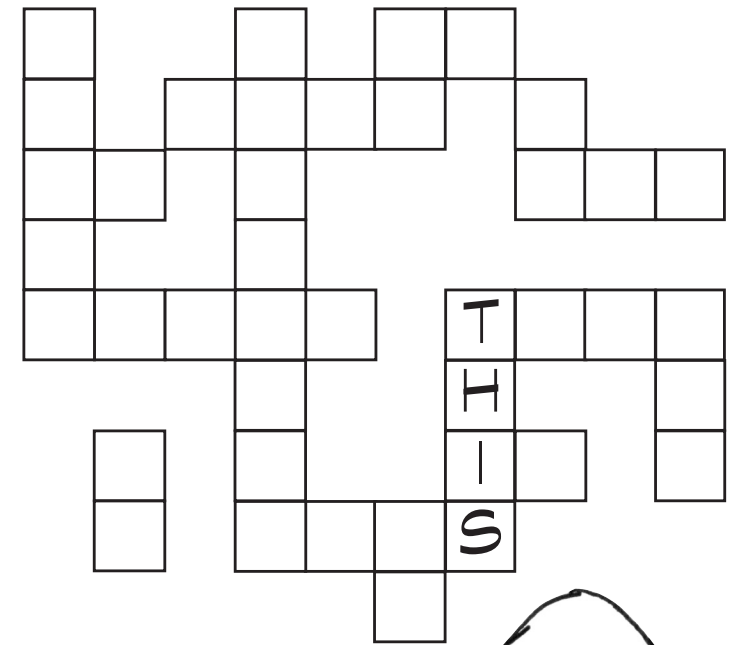
A MAZE

In today's Gospel, Jesus told His disciples to prepare a certain room in a certain house for a very special Passover meal. Help the disciples find the house.



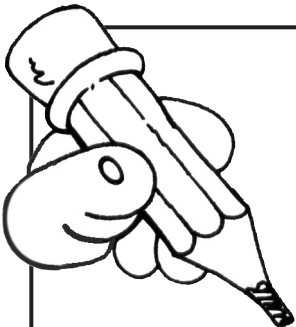

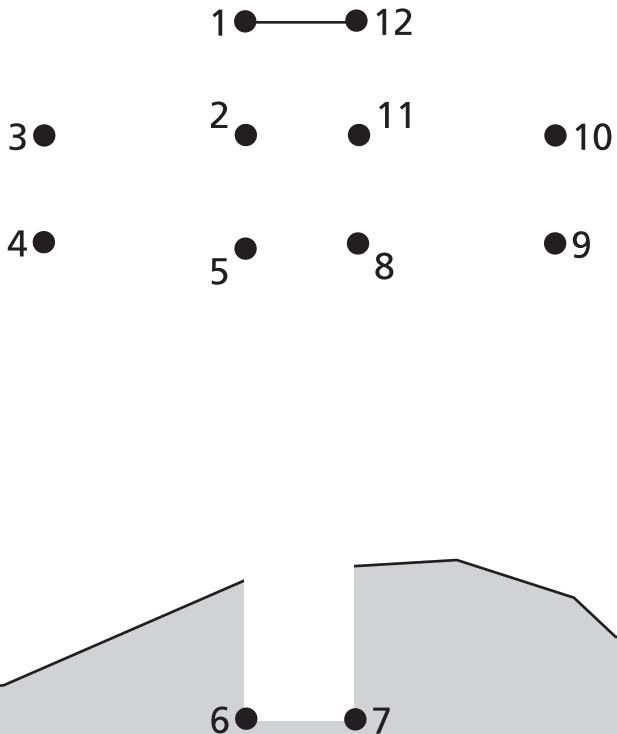

Good Friday did not seem good then. But now we know it was. Because of what Jesus did, we can be God's children forever. Connect the dots to see something that helps us remember Good Friday.

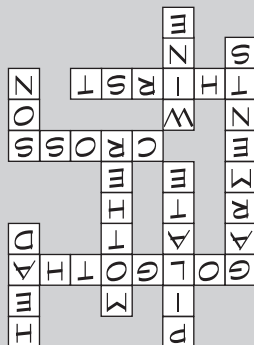

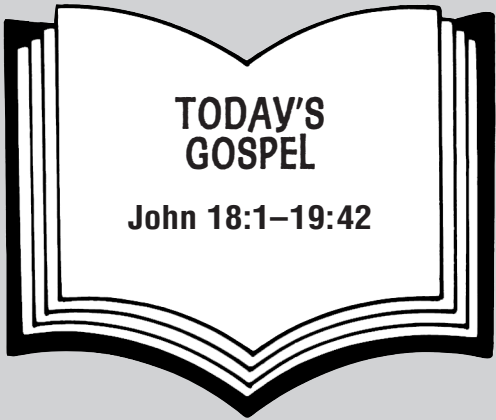

John 19:17-18

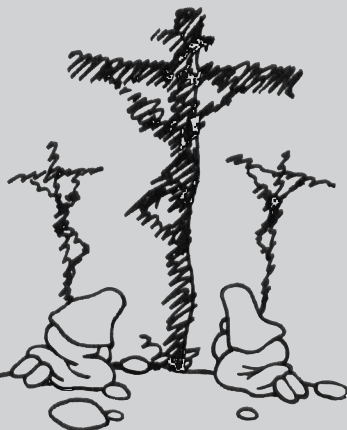
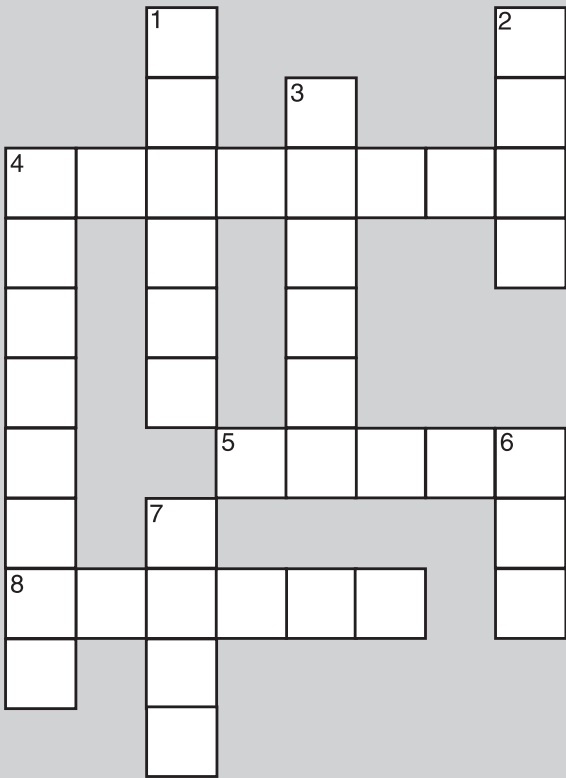
