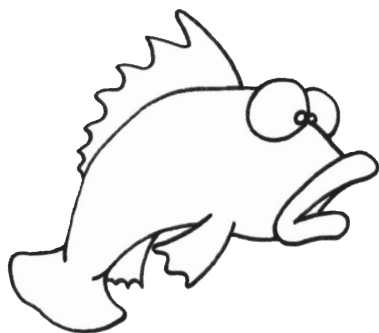
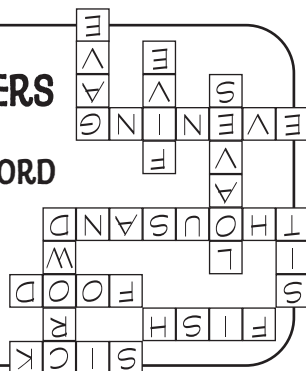




The disciples filled baskets with left-overs after Jesus fed the crowd. To find out how many baskets they filled, color the spaces with dots.



CROSSWORD PUZZLE

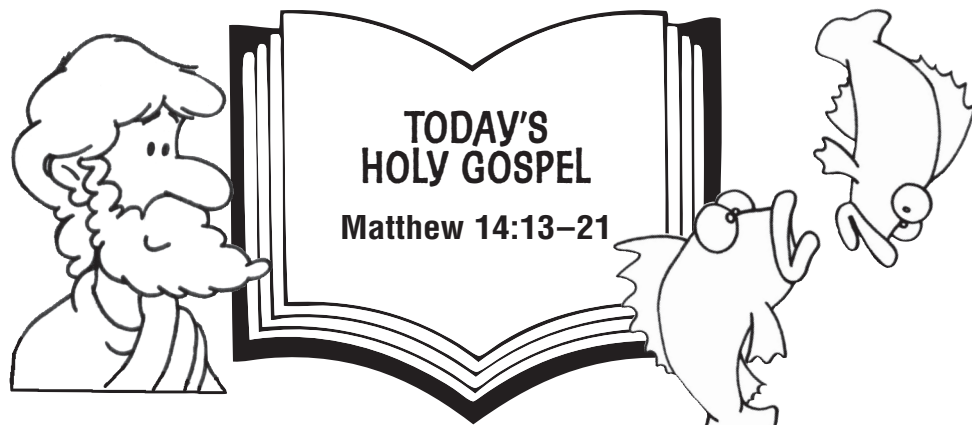

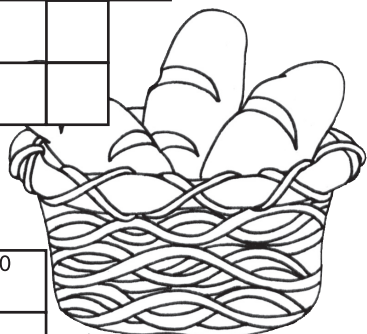
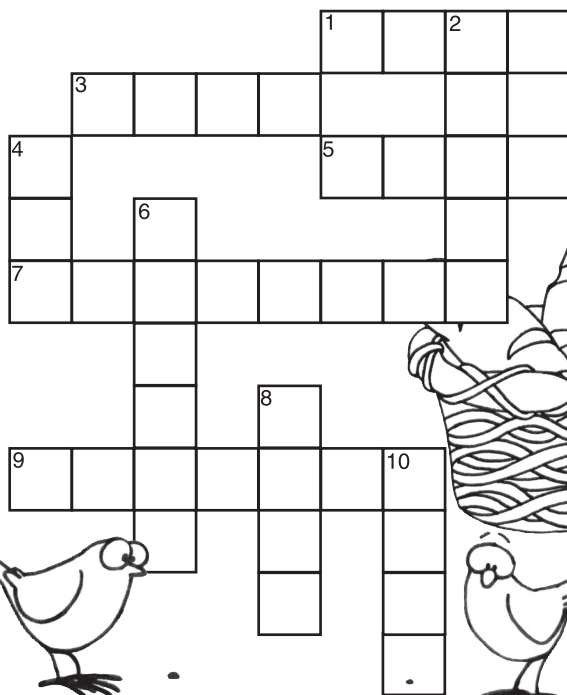
CROSSWORD PUZZLE
